

Watershed reopens to the public

On the 1st September 2020, Watershed will be reopening their doors to the cinemagoers of Bristol.

Watershed is a cross-artform venue set on Bristol's harbour side, offering a diverse programme of films, events, festivals, artist commissions, workshops, and conferences with audiences and participation at its heart. Their cinema programme for September will open with a season of 'Films That Love the Cinema' and love to be seen in the cinema.

'A host of brilliant films that are at their best seen in the unique shared experience of a darkened cinema - something we've all missed over the past few months.'

Watershed will be operating at 25% of capacity in cinemas (with 1.5 metres between each seat) and the Cafe & Bar, with a one-way system for moving around the building and hand sanitisation stations located throughout.

Watershed is asking customers to book a table in advance to avoid disappointment. They've also introduced table service, meaning visitors can now order food on their phone, laptop, or tablet using Watershed's free wi-fi, but they'll also have alternatives for those who might not have access to these.

As well as an enhanced cleaning regime, the Watershed staff will wear PPE and have been trained on all the new health and safety measures. If you are visiting the building you will need to wear a face-covering whilst in the cinemas and moving around the building. However, staff are mindful that some customers and audiences may be unable to wear one.

Watershed also has new opening times. From Tuesday 1 September, they will be open from Tuesday through to Sunday each week and the cinema programme will run from Thursdays to Sundays each week.
